Discussion on Immediate Facility Needs and How to Address Them:

The Committee identified a replacement salt shed as the immediate need. How long the existing shed can be used needs to be determined. Whether another shed on the same site was discussed, there would be a need to a review of zoning/variance requirements for the location. A plan identifying the size and structure make up of a new salt shed needs to be developed along with potential cold storage needs. The secondary need identified was office space. Phillip Braithwaite discussed the need to determine if the space needs to be in the Town Hall or leased space. Terry Hellenbrand has a space available for \$285.00.

Discussion on Future Buildings Space Needs and Layout:

Committee Chairman Jacobson presented a mockup of the potential space on the Enbridge site and potential building sizes. The committee reviewed various layout options by placing the buildings on the site mockup.
