**Resolution 2018-13**  
**Resolution of Town Board to Propose Exceeding Levy Limits**

Whereas, the State of Wisconsin has adopted levy limits on town, village, city and county levies for 2018 and thereafter under s. 66.0602 of Wis. Statutes;

Whereas, s. 66.0602(3)(f)3c. of Wis. Statutes limits the local levy for 2018 to a percentage increase of no more than the greater of (a) 0% of the allowable 2018 payable 2019 adjusted actual levy as calculated under the state's levy limit law or (b) a percentage equal to the percent change in equalized value due to net new construction; which for the Town of Medina is .00425 percent(\$2,358);

Whereas, the Town Board of the Town of Medina, Dane County believes that for the 2018 tax levy (collected in 2019) it is in the town's best interest to exceed the state levy limit as described above (b) by a greater percentage than 0.00425%;(\$2,358)

Whereas, the Town of Medina, Dane County 2018 payable 2018 adjusted actual levy is \$554,821; And further whereas the state law would limit the increase to \$2,358, less \$2,924 for personal property aid; for a total allowable town tax levy of \$554,255 for 2018, collected in 2019.

Now Therefore the Town Board of the Town of Medina, Dane County does hereby resolve, and order as follows:

1. The town board supports an increase in the town tax levy for 2018 (to be collected in 2019) that will exceed the state levy limit.

2. The town board directs that the question of increasing the town tax levy for 2018 (to be collected in 2019) by 1.5 percent over the allowable 2018 levy limit, which would increase the town levy by \$8,314 on an ongoing basis, for a total town tax levy of \$562,569 (including debt service), shall be placed on the agenda for the Special Town Meeting to be held on Wednesday December 5, 2018.

3. The purpose of the tax levy increase is to support the increased budgetary operating expense that can no longer be funded from available funds due to increased operating and public safety costs.
