



Dear Town of Medina Resident,

Badger Challenge (formerly The Ride), a community fundraiser benefiting cancer research at UW-Madison, will take place on roads within the Town of Medina on **Sunday, September 25, 2022**.

The following roads will be used by bikers between 7:30-10:00 AM.

- **W Medina Rd** from Ridge Rd to Oak Park Rd
- **Oak Park Rd** from W Medina Rd to Madison St
- **Madison St** from Oak Park Rd to E Main St
- **E Main St** from Madison St to Box Elder Rd
- **Box Elder Rd** from E Main St to Veith Rd
- **Veith Rd** from Box Elder Rd to Cty Hwy O

All roads will be open to vehicle traffic and bikers are required to follow the rules of the road and use standard cycling signals. Riders are also instructed to ride as far right as possible and to ride single file as they are aware roads are open and they must let cars pass legally.

We estimate that there will be 800 bikers in this time period, but they will be spread out as these roads are being used by two different courses with staggered start times.
